

... on the use of LEINOS Products

The following guidelines should always be followed when using LEINOS products. Product-specific application, hazard, and safety instructions can be found in the respective technical data sheets and safety data sheets. **These can be viewed and downloaded at www.leinos.de.**

1. General safety instructions

- 1.1. LEINOS products should always be kept out of the reach of children.
- 1.2. If medical advice is needed, have the packaging or label ready.
- 1.3. Read the provided documents, such as technical data sheets and safety data sheets, carefully and follow the instructions. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us (Email: info@leinos.de, Phone: +49 4163 / 86747-0).
- 1.4. When using spray equipment, approved respiratory protection must be worn.
- 1.5. A fine dust mask must be worn when sanding.
- 1.6. Many LEINOS products, including water-based ones, contain binders derived from vegetable oils. Due to the vegetable oil content, work materials saturated with the product, such as rags and cloths, pose a risk of spontaneous combustion. These should therefore initially be stored in airtight metal containers and/or submerged in water. Before disposal (see Section 3 "General Cleaning and Disposal Instructions"), these should be spread out, separated from other flammable materials, and dried.

2. General application instructions

- 2.1. To achieve optimal results, be sure to consult the technical data sheets for all products used BEFORE APPLICATION. These are available from your dealer or at www.leinos.de.
- 2.2. Due to the natural raw materials used, a characteristic odor may occur.
- 2.3. Color specifications and color swatches are non-binding. Color variations are possible depending on the batch, substrate, and printing technique. The dried original color differs from the fresh color in the container. Therefore, a test coat with color matching is essential. Mix different batches of the same color together.

3. General cleaning and disposal instructions

- 3.1. Liquid products must always be disposed of via a special disposal method, such as at a recycling center, a hazardous waste collection point, or a suitable waste disposal company.
- 3.2. Cleaning fluids, such as thinners or wash water, must be disposed of in the same manner as liquid products and should never be poured down the drain or otherwise released into the environment.
- 3.3. Brushes and other tools must not be cleaned under running water.
- 3.4. Containers, such as cans or buckets, that still contain product residue must be disposed of in the same manner as the liquid product.
- 3.5. Cleaned containers can be recycled.
- 3.6. Dried brushes, rags, or cloths may be disposed of in the general waste.
